THE ANCIENT MAZDAYASNI CALENDAR is the most accurate calendar that has ever existed in the civilized world to this day. It is a blueprint of the events in Nature. It highlights the significant occurrences in Nature and celebrates them as festivals. In comparison, the universally used Gregorian calendar is a political patchwork to add the names of Julia Caesar (July) and Augustus (August), evident from the 12th month being called December, which means the 10th and the 9th month, September (7th). The 10th month is October, which means the 8th. This also proves that the Gregorian year originally started in Spring.

In the MazdaYasni calendar, the year always starts on the Vernal Equinox, so the leap year is automatically determined by nature. The calendar's accuracy is further enhanced by dividing the days of each season. Thus, each season starts on the first of every fourth month and is celebrated as a festival. Seasons are marked by the position of the Earth in its orbit around the Sun, so the calendar's accuracy is guaranteed by nature. The four seasons are celebrated as follows:

1. **Vernal Equinox**, the beginning of Spring as New Year

THIS SHOWS THE IRANIANS KNEW OF THE MOVEMENT OF THE EARTH AROUND THE SUN OVER 2000 YEARS BEFORE GALILEO



The four positions of the sun and the four seasons, although they may seem to be of equal length, are not equal in reality. The path of the Earth around the Sun is such that it DOES NOT divide the time taken to travel, from one position to another, into four equal parts, as one would ordinarily believe. None of the four parts are equal. Spring has **92.8** days, Summer **93.6** days, Autumn **89.9** days, and winter is the shortest with **88.9** days. Each season individually divided works out to 31 days each for the first six months, the next 5 months of 30 days each and the last month of the balance of the days before the Vernal Equinox, which is 29 or 30 determined by the Vernal Equinox.

The MazdaYasni calendar has been designed based on this premise and incorporates other traditions. The traditional 30 names of the days of the Sasanian era are used, and the 31st day of the first 6 months has been named "Avardad," the Pahlavi word meaning "extra day." See Philosophy of naming days.

The Seven Days of the Week have been named after the Haft Amesha Spentas, The Seven Eternal Laws, to remind us constantly of the path to progress.

SOME FACTS: Professor Martin Haug discovered the Gathas from among the Yasnas in 1859, so the five Gatha days were named thereafter. This means the Zoroastrian Shehanshahi and Kadmi calendars are of recent origin, while the Fasli calendar was introduced in 1906 in India and accepted by the Iranian Zarathushtries after the 1960s. It is based on the Roman calendar and emulates the 360 degrees of the circle.

PHILOSOPHY BEHIND NAMING THE DAYS IN THE MONTH

The National Science Foundation in the US has concluded that a regular person has about 70 thousand thoughts in a day. The result is a waste of brain power. None of the thoughts can mature because the mind has less than one second to delve into each thought. Recently, science has realised that if a group of people, over a period, collectively think about a single subject, single problem or a single project, they can find solutions and advance in their research at a faster pace. Many hi-tech companies have started to put this into practice.

The MazdaYasni Zarathushtis were aware of this mental downside and had a solution; they named the days to promote a unified thought and action during each day. For example, on days named Peace, Life, Moon, and Good Thoughts, "Life" is revered by not slaughtering animals or eating meat. The collective action of not killing and not eating meat on four specified days had a dual effect on the population's health and helped preserve animal species.

Naming the day's Water, Wind, Fire, Justice, Victory, and Love was not to ask for boon and blessings from them but to work towards preserving and promoting them. Today, we have Earth Day, Mother's Day, Father's Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, etc. Of course, the names were not chosen haphazardly. We see a pattern: the first part is the AmeshaSpanta. The second is life-related, which refers to all the elements that support life. The third is feelings-related, including wind, which is felt, not seen. The last group is conscience-related.

These are related to TRUTH and should not be turned into Superstition.

NOW RUZ

Now Ruz, the New Year is the celebration of the Vernal Equinox and the Rejuvenation in nature. All the people who once formed the great Persian Empire celebrate it. (44 per cent of the world population was part of the Persian Empire). Now Ruz comprises two Persian words, Now meaning New and Ruz meaning Day. According to Persian mythology, King Jamshid celebrated the first spring after the great ice age, which science proves happened 10,000 years ago. Since then, it has been part of the Iranian culture, and they have shared it with all they came in contact with. As for the coining of the word Now Ruz, meaning New Day, it goes back to 1725 BCE and was coined by Zarathushtra, the great Sage of Ancient Iran, who also calculated the Earth's Natural Meridian at 63 degrees longitude, which he named Nim Ruz meaning Mid-Day.

When the sun is at mid-day (Nim Ruz) over 63 degrees longitude, the entire hemisphere from Japan and Australia to Europe and Africa has sunlight. (Mehr Yasht 103-4). Zarathushtra also calculated that in the year 1725 BCE, the Vernal Equinox would coincide with the Sunrise in the kingdom of Balkh, where he lived. Thereby, the New Year and the New Day would start simultaneously. To record this rare phenomenon, he named that particular New Year, Now Ruz - the New Day. Thus, NOW RUZ happens where the sunrise coincides with the Vernal Equinox. As archaeologically recorded in history, in 487 BCE, once again, Now Ruz was celebrated, this time at Persepolis where the First Rays of the rising sun lighted the specially erected stone pillar in the Apadana palace, at precisely the exact moment as the Vernal Equinox.

CELEBRATION: The highlight of the Now Ruz celebration is the arrangement of the symbolic Now Ruz Table, which consists of seven items. The ancient Persians, all followers of Zarathushtra, decorated their table with Seven Trays (HAFT SEENIE) filled with numerous symbolic items. The Seven Trays represented the SEVEN ETERNAL LAWS OF NATURE as derived from the "Gathas," the songs of Zarathushtra (Ha28.3). It was a way of renewing their bond and reminding them of the path they needed to follow.

ZARATHUSHTRA'S BIRTH ANNIVERSARY

Zarathushtra, the Sage of ancient Iran, was born on the 6th day after the Vernal Equinox. As for his birth, 1768 BCE is calculated based on the astronomical indication in the Avesta and published for the first time by Prof. Zabih Behrooz. Western scholars in this field have been confused and have given varying and misleading dates. The coinciding of the Sun Rise with the Equinox in 1725 in Balkh and the coining of the word Nim Ruz by Zarathushtra is proof. FOR MORE INFO:

3rd Ardibehest -22/ 23 April is the Ardibehest day in Ardibehest Month and is celebrated as Nature Day.

Asha Vahista -The Ultimate Truth – The Truth found in nature.

GAHANBARS (Celebrating Nature)

Gahanbars are seasonal festivals of Thanksgiving. It is when people celebrate their collaboration with nature by respecting nature. There are 4 seasons, but there are 6 Gahanbars. Out of respect for history, tradition, and the enjoyment of life with festivity, the celebration of the two seasonal festivals of the ancestral homeland in the Arctic was preserved by the migrating Zarathushtis. At the same time, they introduced four new Gahanbars for the four seasons of their new temperate homeland. The names of the Gahanbars point to The Exact Day of the celebration and leave no doubt.



ARCTIC Gahanbars

Maidhyo-Shahem (Mid-Summer) Gahanbars. Arctic Summer lasts 7 months (Farvardin to Mehr) and 216 days, so mid-summer falls on the 108th day, which is 15 of Tir, corresponding to July 6.

Ayeh-Threm (Saarem) (Coming of Winter). The Arctic winter lasts five months. (Aban to Espand) The Coming of Winter is celebrated just before the Arctic winter starts in Aban. So (30 Mehr) (21/22 October).

TEMPERATE Gahanbars

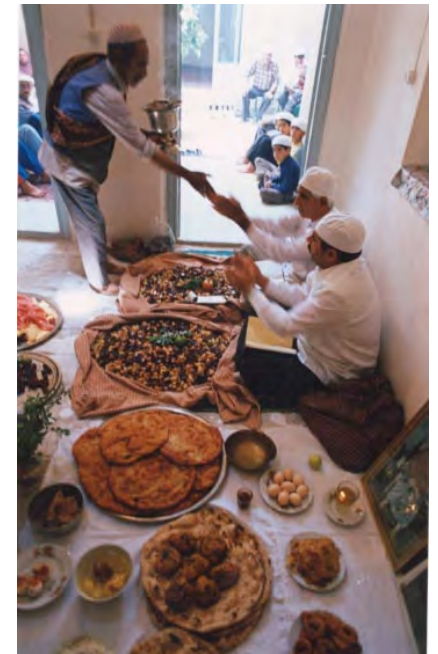
Maidhyo-Zarem (mid-Spring): Spring has 92.8 days, so mid-Spring falls on the 46th day (15 Ardibesht 4/5 May).

Paiti-Shahem (End of Summer): Summer ends on the 186th day (31 Shahrivar 21/22 Sept.).

Maidh-Yarem (Mid-winter): 320.75th day. When farmers, shepherds and their animals are resting. (14 Bahman 2 Feb).

Hamas-Path-Maedem (Equality of heat and cold, day and night): preparation for the revival of Nature. (28/ 29 Espand) (March 19/20). Gahanbars were a social gathering of fun and festivity with dance and music. After the Arab invasion, the Gahanbars were forced underground and became solemn events in memory of the millions who were massacred. Under those conditions, there was no room for fun and festivity, and atrocities were committed daily to the extent that the population was reduced to just 7,711 heads in Iran when Maneckji Limji Hataria came to their rescue in 1854.

NAMES OF THE DAYS OF THE WEEK

The division of the month and year into weeks is well established in the modern international culture, and all activities are closely integrated with them. All three Zarathushti Calendars have borrowed the names of the days of the week from the dominant cultures. The Shahenshahi calendar has borrowed the names of the Indian weeks -Som, Magal, Budh, Guru, .etc. The Kadmi and Fasli borrowed from the Semitic calendar Shanbeh, Ek Shanbeh, DoShanbeh SayShanbeh, etc.

In the Mazdayasni Calendar, the days of the week are named after the Amesha Spentas. They will be a weekly reminder of the Gathic path, in the right order, to Perfection, Immortality, and Spirituality, as mentioned above.

Zarathushti culture promotes happiness and believes in enjoying life on earth. All the festivals and holidays are for happy occasions, and even festivals that have lost their original significance have not been discarded, like the two Arctic Gahanbars. Thus, adding a few more festivals to celebrate the coinciding of the week's names with the names of the days would not be out of place. That is when the names of the Amesha Spentas in the week coincide with that of the day. This can happen one or two times a year. In addition, when the names of the day, the week, and the month coincide, a super festivity can be held.

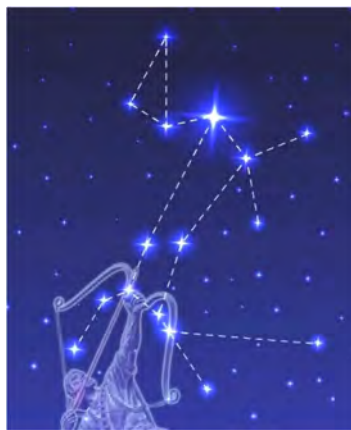

All ancient MazdaYasni festivals celebrated landmarks in the earth's journey around the sun and seasonal events in nature. This shows the Iranians had precise knowledge about the Earth and its movement around the sun thousands of years before Galileo and the Western World accepted the truth.

Tirgan is the celebration of the **Summer Solstice**. On this day, the sun reaches the northernmost position on the earth, and as a result, the Northern Hemisphere has the longest day. People spend this day outdoors, and because it is hot, they spray water on each other; thus, it has become the festival of water.

Simultaneously, the Southern Hemisphere has the Shortest Day, the Winter Solstice. So the whole world can celebrate, although for different events.



Arash-e-Kamangir is an Iranian mythological character who shoots an arrow from Mount Damavand to the banks of River Jehun to demarcate the border between Iran and its arch-enemy, Turan. The festival of Tirgan is supposed to celebrate this feat.

The real story is in the Tir Yasht of the Avesta, originally a cosmological paper on Tishtarya, the brightest star in the sky. The archer and his bow and arrow are Asterisms formed by seven stars. The arrow's flight from Mount Khshaotha to Mount Hvanvant shows the path of Tishtarya in the sky. It became a prayer by adding a few devotional sentences at some point in history. Later, under Greek influence, the Pahlavi text on Tishtarya converted facts into fiction by personifying the constellations. After that, in the Islamic era, each writer presented a different version of the Pahlavi folklore. In the last century, this myth was further developed by nationalists. The latest and most popular version of Arash-e-Kamangir is a poem by the politician poet Siavash Kasrai written in 1959.

Based on those calendars Pateti is celebrated as New Year, lately there are efforts to call it Navroj, that has created confusion with the Now Rooz that is celebrated in March on the Vernal Equinox by millions of people that once formed the Persian Empire. This could result in modern day Zarathushtris losing ownership of the real Now Rooz. So just like the two Gahanbars and the Sadeh festival of the Arctic homeland have been preserved and celebrated giving us a link to our ancient history. Pateti can be the link to the migration and the welcome received on the shores of India.

In the MazdaYasni calendar the 5-day Muktad prayers will keep alive the memory (Amordad) of the millions of brethren lost in the Genocide and thereafter. An Empire reduced to a hundred thousand who took refuge in India and the 7711 who braved the odds as infidels and kept alive their faith in the mother land.

Mehregan is the celebration of the Autumnal Equinox.
Just like Now Ruz on Mehregan, the day and night are equal.

The Earth, in its revolution around the sun, goes through two equinoxes; it is a moment in time when the sun crosses the equator, one around 20 March First of Farvardin (Now Ruz) and the second around 22 September First of Mehr (Mehregan). Ancient Iranians have celebrated both of these occasions with great fanfare. Recognising such precise moments in the revolution of the Earth around the Sun and celebrating it shows the knowledge of the ancient Iranians in comparison with the belief of the rest of the world, who, in 1633 CE, punished Galileo for simply mentioning that the Earth went around the sun. No doubt, the Bible calls the Persians Wise.



ARCTIC Gahanbars

Ayeh-Threm (Saarem) (Coming of Winter)

It is one of the two Gahanbars celebrated when the Zarathushtis' ancestors lived in the Arctic. As the name says, it celebrates the coming of winter and is celebrated on 30 Mehr (Oct 21/22), just before the Arctic winter starts from the First of Aban.

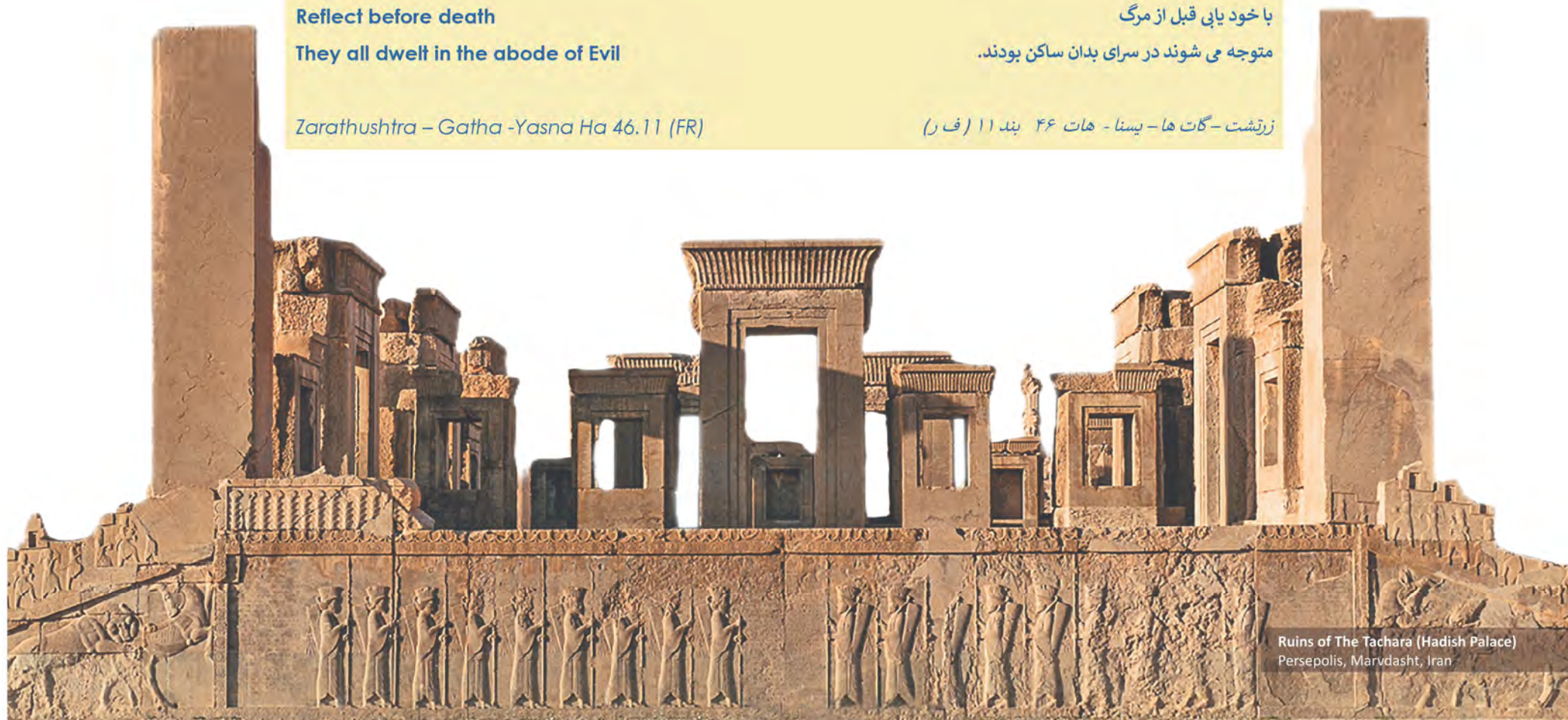

In the Gathic concept, fire pertains to the heat of internal zeal for creating progress and making the world a better place.

The teachings of Zarathushtra, the sage of ancient Iran, have nothing to do with physical fire. The Gathas of Zarathushtra are a recipe for progress towards perfection. It is not about worship; it is about doing and achieving. It is not about asking for a boon but about dreaming and converting the right dreams into reality. The followers of the teachings of Zarathushtra have chosen fire as a

medium, as a facilitator of their path towards perfection, and in their quest for self-realisation - Khod-Ah, realising the God within. Fire is never considered to be a god of any sort. Fire has a mystical effect compared to air, water, and earth. It gives one the feeling of spiritual elevation. Concentrating on the flickering flames mesmerises and relaxes the mind. It helps the mind enter the Alpha stage, where the mind works at its best—solving problems and decoding the mysteries of the universe. This is seen as worshipping to the superstitious mind and the opponents.

Yalda, or Zayesh-e-Mehr, celebrates the Winter Solstice; its highlight is the longest night. It is the start of the winter season, which lasts 88.9 days and is the shortest. In Mithraism, this day was celebrated as the birth of the Sun because from the next day, the days get longer, and the sun is growing according to them. They called this day "Zayesh e Mehr" - Birth of Mehr-the Sun. Yalda is a Syriac translation coined by the Assyrian Christians who replaced the Sun God with the Son of God. The celebration of Deygan's long winter night involved the recitation and discussion of the Gathas, which, on the revival of the festival by the Iranians, was replaced by the recitation of the 14-century poems of Hafez; today, Zarathushtis, unaware of their past, do the same.

CELEBRATION OF THE LIFE OF ZARATHUSHTRA

Dey 5 / December 25

Zarathushtra, the Sage of ancient Iran, was born on the 6th day after the Vernal Equinox in 1768 BCE. Zarathushtra, at a young age, was in quest of knowledge. He wanted to find out the purpose of life on earth. He found his answer in nature, but when he proclaimed it, he met with opposition in the country of his birth. So, he left and searched for someone who would understand him. He found that person in King Vistasp of Balkh and his wise ministers, Jamasp and Frashaoshtra. It is said he was 30 years of age when his teachings were accepted. Thus, 1738 BCE is considered the first year of establishing his school of thought, named the 'Mazda Yasni' (Reverence unto

Wisdom, those who respect and pursue Wisdom). In the Avesta, it is repeatedly mentioned as 'Mazdayasno Ahmi Mazdayasno Zarathushtrish'. In the first verse of his Gathas, he seeks and wants everyone to seek WISDOM.

He passed away at the age of 77. He practised what he preached and achieved immortality with his Gathas, which throughout history have influenced civilizations and will continue to influence them to progress towards Perfection in harmony with Nature.

Saadeh is a festival that originated in Aryana Vaejah, the Arctic home of the Zarathushtis' ancestors. Saad means hundred, and Saadeh celebrates the hundredth day of Arctic winter, which falls on the 10th of Bahman (30 January). Winter in the Arctic begins 30 days after the Autumnal Equinox, marked with the celebration of Ayeh Threm (Coming of Winter) Gahanbar. The severity of the Arctic winter reduces after 100 days, and people start preparing for the Arctic summer.

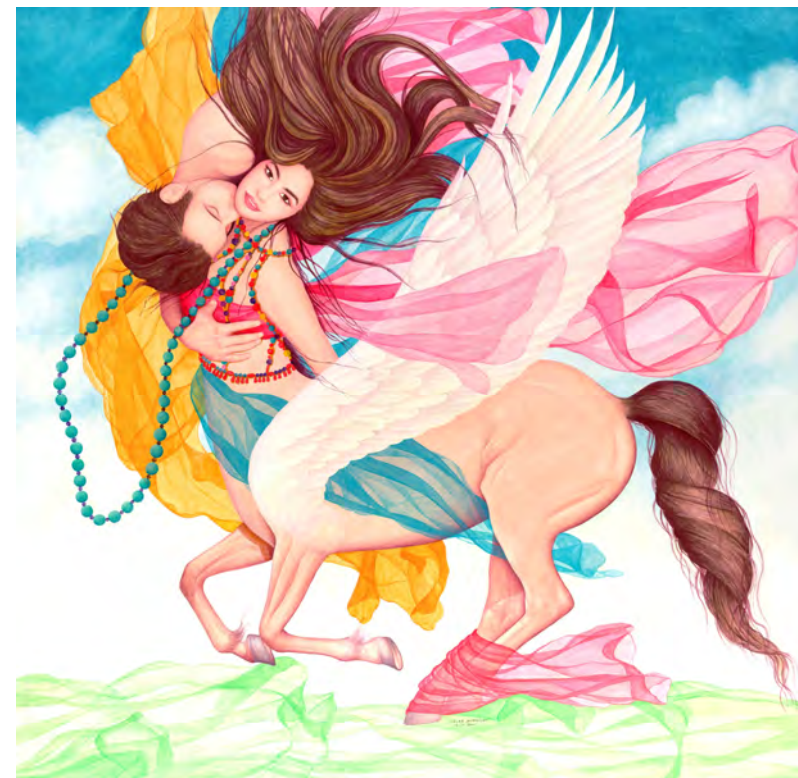
